



Checklist of items needed on or before horse is delivered to farm.

Ship-in lesson horses must have items 1 through 5.

NO HORSES will be brought on the premises without this paperwork!

- Copy of horse registration papers showing current owner
- Copy of lease contract if horse is leased
- Copy of health records including current vaccines and worming
- Current Negative Coggins report
- Signed Release and Waiver
- Signed and completed farm contracts
- Tail set (Saddlebreds only, if needed for show purposes)

Optional

- Halter
- Blankets
- Grooming Supplies
- Stall toys
- Any special needs tack specific to your horse you think we may need

Feeding program:

A 12% protein pelleted feed or a low calorie vitamin mineral pellet is fed twice daily and each horse is given a grass mix hay four times per day. We also supplement a coat enhancer and weight gainer formula to horses that require it. Daily feedings are adjusted accordingly per each horse's individual condition and training needs.

We endorse and bill monthly per horse the following supplements:

Cosequin Joint supplement Succeed Digestive Conditioning Aid FormulaS Hoof Supplement

Any feeding needs outside our regular program can be discussed with the understanding that the horse owner will absorb the additional cost of specialty feeds and all supplements required by the horse.

Worming:

February: Fenbendazole
April: 1.87% Ivermectin Tapeworm Combo
June: Pyrantel Pamoate
August: Fenbendazole
October: 1.87% Ivermectin Tapeworm Combo
December: Pyrantel Pamoate

Wormer will be purchased and administered by us and charged to the following month's board.

Spring shot series - administered mid-April to ALL horses and ponies.

ALL animals are required to have blood drawn for Coggins. Sorry, no vet discount for ponies.

Billed on May Board and Training bill.

Shots will include: **Flu, Rhino, Eastern/ Western, Tetanus, West Nile Single booster and Coggins**

Fall shot series – administered mid-September

Billed on November Board and Training bill.

Shots will include: **Flu, Rhino boosters, Rabies**

Dental Care:

All horses on the farm will be checked regularly for the need for proper dental care. We require a minimum of a yearly dental float but performance horses may require more. We retain the services of a well-established Equine Dentist for our dental care. You will be advised of your horses needs and billed accordingly.
